Austrian Winter Peas - \$1.99 per pound

Austrian Winter Peas grow very well in cooler soils and are very hardy. They also do well in heavy soils, are a good weed competitor and an excellent nitrogen fixer for the soil. They mature early and attract beneficial insects to the growing area in early spring. Sow Oct. - Dec. Recommended seeding rate is 1 pound per 200 sq. ft.

Fava Beans - \$1.99 per pound TEMPORARILY OUT OF STOCK

Favas are not really a bean, but a member of the pea family. This tall legume is vigorous, deep rooted, and an excellent nitrogen fixer. It produces long pods filled with edible beans and flowers. Plant in rows 12" apart. Plant seeds 5" apart and 1" deep. Sow in mid to late October. Recommended seeding rate is 1 pound per 300 sq. ft.

Crimson Clover - \$4.99 per pound

Grows readily on most soil types, but does not tolerate poor drainage. It forms a dense green carpet by mid winter, and matures in April. The tender vegetation does not multiply by runners and is easily tilled into the bed, adding organic matter to the soil. This annual, like other legumes, captures free nitrogen from the air and converts it to a form available to other plants. Sow Sept. to mid-October. Recommended seeding rate is 1 pound per 400 sq. ft.

Annual Rye Grass - \$1.99 per pound

This cool season grass is an annual. It is adapted to late fall seeding, germinating rapidly and growing throughout the cold season. It tolerates heavy soils. It also tolerates low pH ranges. It has excellent root mass which helps to control weeds. When tilled into the soil in the spring, it adds organic matter to improve the soil texture and workability. Sow Sept. through Nov. Recommended seeding rate is 1 pound per 500 sq. ft.
